

# Pastor's Ponderings

You can walk through a good produce market at different times and find all kinds of peas - garden peas, English peas, field peas, snow peas, snap peas, purple hull peas, black eye peas, and chick peas. We recently looked at the **3 P's** of the church – **preaching**, **praying**, and **personal relationships**. Let me lay out <u>3 more</u> P's for your consideration over the next couple of months: **perusal**, **pic**, and **program**.

Perusal = (noun) an examination or consideration with attention to detail.

Starting in September we begin a *perusal* of the gospel of Mark, examining and considering in detail its content and life lessons for us. We'll wade through it slowly and deliberately. Be faithful in your worship attendance / participation and ask God to speak to you through His Word?!

*Pic* – short for picture – we all know what that means.

It's past time to update a pictorial directory of our church family, so we going to do so in a low-impact way. Gather your immediate church-attending family members with you with decent lighting and in front of a blank, neutral-colored wall, get the selfy-stick and your phone and take a selfy (or get someone to take a pic for you). Also send us a pic of just you individually. After we receive the pics, we'll print sheets of pics that you can used to assemble a directory.

**Program** – well, maybe programs isn't the best word – maybe "tool" is better.

**Who'syourOne?** is designed to be a tool you can use to identify and share the gospel with one person that is far from God. We really don't need another program or even more "soul-winning" training.

What we need is a burden, biblical approach, and obedient feet. *Who'sYourOne* invites you to:

Identify – pray and ask God who your one ought to be

Intercede – pray, not just about them, but pray for your ONE.

Investment – create connecting points to relationship building with your ONE.

Intentionality – look for opportunities to have spiritual conversations with your ONE.

Invitation – make an effort to share the gospel with your ONE.

Want to see a great movement of God in the Alvarado community? It starts with God's people sharing God's heart / burden, then praying and being obedient to His vision / plan. Over the next couple of months you will be introduced to this "tool".

"God answers prayer" or as Lk.11:10 puts it, For everyone who asks receives... On the last Sunday night in August a group of about 18 met for prayer and prayed for a number of our member and families with needs – many physical ones, some spiritual ones. Over the last week or so, it has been a delight to see God answer many of those needs with His marvelous grace! Keep praying and believing. He is a God who can be trusted to provide for us just what we need...just when we need it.

Continue to pray for our *Associate Pastor of Worship* Search Committee as they deal with 2 men and look for God's will – and for those 2 young men as they look for God's will as well.

## Discipleship

The school year has begun and as we say good bye to activities of summer, and hopefully the hot temperatures soon, one thing that will continue, as we move forward into the fall, is our journey through God's word. Currently every person who is attending a Sunday Morning Bibles Study Group (aka Sunday School) is studying through a chronological three year plan to study the bible. The curriculum we use is called the Gospel Project and it was specifically chosen to allow all age groups the best understanding of Bible. In addition it was chosen because it encourages discipleship within the family unit.



And it was also chosen because it provides a plan and resources to allow the reader to practice the discipline of daily reading of God's word. Research has identified the practice of reading the Bible every day as the single most significant practice to develop spiritual maturity. This is basically what is called making life and heart space. Make room in your life and in your schedule to hear from God. Make heart space to let God's word change you and then his teachings will flow out from you. It is a beautiful thing to watch how so many of our peoples lives are being changed because they have created this discipline. Unfortunately, not all of our church family is involved in the practice and they are missing out on the joy that comes from knowing God on a deeper level. Now would be a great time to speak a word of encouragement to someone who is missing out. Maybe there is someone in your Bible Study Group that has been missing for a while. Maybe there has been illness or situation that is very difficult and they do not know what to do. Maybe they just need to be invited to come back. They just need to know they are missed. Why not ask! Now would be a great time to invite a friend or neighbor to come with you to your Bible Study Group. Again, research says that people are most likely to attend a church or Bible study when they are invited by a family member or friend. Never assume they are not interested or too busy. Why not ask!


# Children's Discipleship & Missions

We have also been able to take advantage of many exciting training opportunities this summer, for management and teaching staff.


