The first big "I" is <u>Intention</u> -- God's Christmas Intention for us all. The name *Jesus* comes from the Hebrew name *Joshua* which means "Jehovah will save." His very name hints at God's intention -- that He would send his Son in order to save us! As Gal.4:4-5 tells us, *But when the fulness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adaption as sons. The manger (and the cross) was no mistake, but was God's plan all along!*

The second big "I" is <u>Incarnation</u> -- the God of the universe came down from heaven and took on human flesh -- as Jn.1:14 says, *And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen His glory...* Jesus is God with skin on Him. That's what His name *Immanuel* means -- God with us.

Since Jesus has moved into our neighborhood with His message, what opportunities we have this season to move into our neighborhood with Him and His message.


