Important Questions

A student had his first college philosophy test. It consisted of a single question on a page, “Is this a question? Discuss.” After sitting there a few minutes he wrote, “If that is a question, then this is an answer.” Yep, he got an “A” on the test!

Sometimes having the right answers starts with the right questions -- questions that lead to deeper thought and spiritual awareness. Jesus loved to ask leading questions-- some examples...

To John & Andrew who turned to follow Jesus, Jesus asked, “*What are you seeking?*” (Jn.1:38)

To the invalid man lying by the pool of Bethesda, Jesus asked, “*Do you want to be healed?*” (Jn.5:6)

To the panicked disciples in the boat on the lake after the storm was calmed, Jesus asked, “*Where is your faith?*” All questions that lead to deeper understanding and dependence upon Himself.

Our FBCA family needs to continue to ask some important questions -- questions that lead to deeper thought and spiritual awareness. Some of those questions might go something like these...

“What has made FBCA a unique fellowship in the past?”

“Do you think that FBCA’s best days are ahead of us, or behind us?”

“What would FBCA be like if my own personal study of Scripture, prayer life, and personal outreach of was the standard of measure?”

CAMP CAMP CAMP!

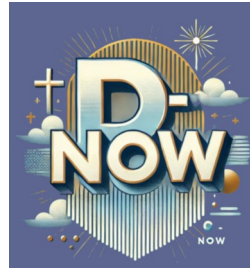
